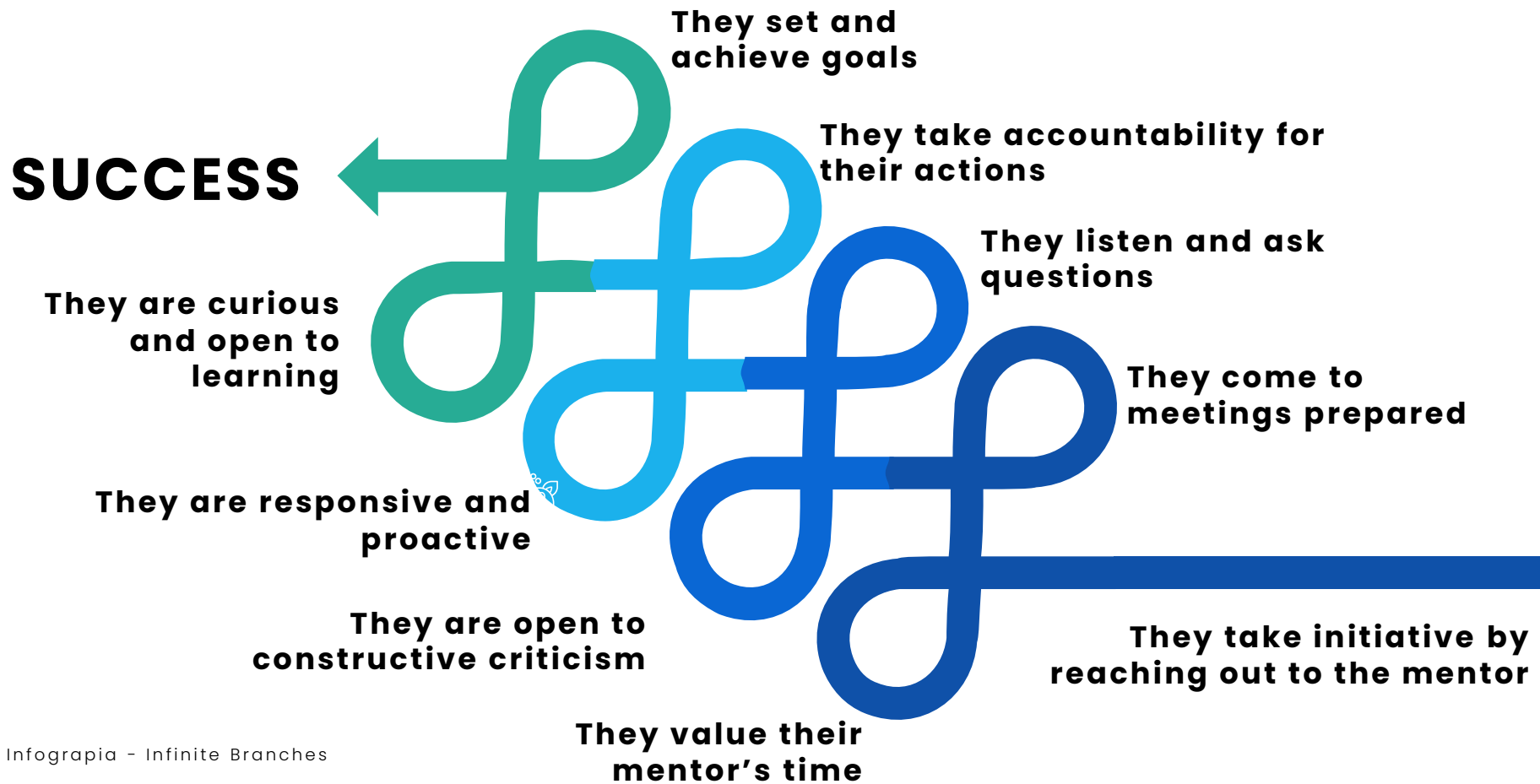

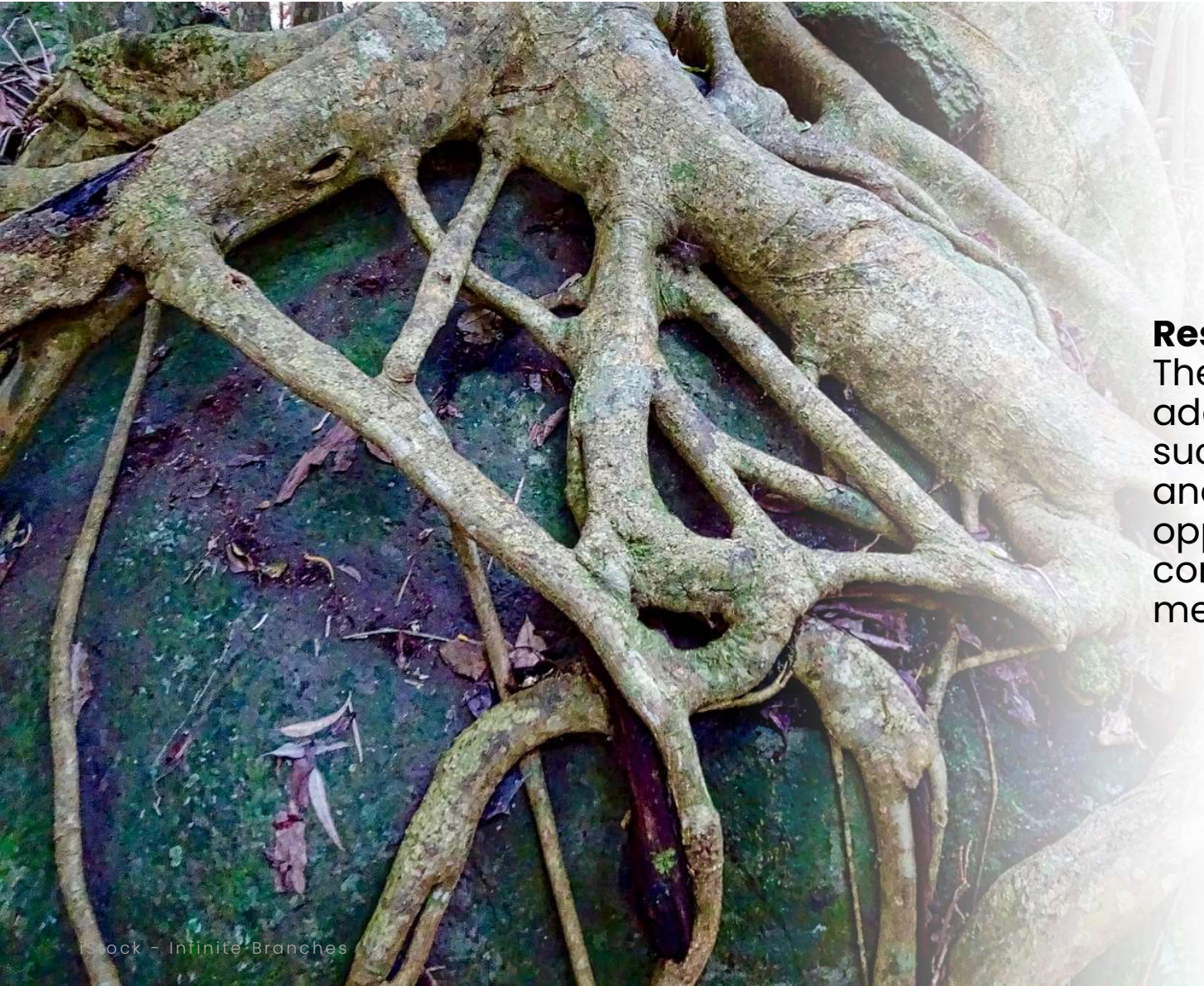
Open-Mindedness:




Consistency:
